







COVID POLICY CHART (as of 9/6/22)

<u>Policy</u>	<u>Status</u>	<u>Notes/Details</u>
<p>Masks</p> 	<p>Optional for all except:</p>	<p>1) when still testing positive (wear for 10 days after symptom onset or positive test) or 2) reason to suspect close contact (wear while someone in household is positive +10 days)</p> <p><i>*note that children under 2 are not allowed to wear masks</i></p>
<p>Vaccinations</p> 	<p>Required for staff, strongly encouraged for families</p>	<p>In addition to all of our staff, almost all of the RSCC families have gotten them as well. The number, timing & type of boosters people get may vary greatly for each person.</p>
<p>Testing</p> 	<p>Use as needed</p>	<p>Rapid test to determine when no longer infectious after a positive case; rapid test daily for 10 days after probable close contact exposure</p>
<p>Return from Infection</p> 	<p>Negative rapid test or after 7 days</p>	<p>Return when symptoms abate AND EITHER 1) test negative on rapid test or 2) after being out for 7 days</p>
	<p>Not necessary with testing & masking</p>	<p>Not necessary for classroom exposures and not necessary for other exposures such as household close contacts provided testing & masking for 10 days past the exposure</p>
<p>Notifications</p> 	<p>Contact office if child is ill; School will notify if there is an outbreak situation</p>	<p>Let the Office know about your child's illness; we will let you know if outbreak in child's classroom, but no more school wide notifications</p>
