

COVID POLICY CHART (as of 9/6/22)

<u>Policy</u>	<u>Status</u>	Notes/Details
Masks	Optional for all except:	 when still testing positive (wear for 10 days after symptom onset or positive test) or reason to suspect close contact (wear while someone in household is positive +10 days) *note that children under 2 are not allowed to wear masks
Vaccinations	Required for staff, strongly encouraged for families	In addition to all of our staff, almost all of the RSCC families have gotten them as well. The number, timing & type of boosters people get may vary greatly for each person.
Testing	Use as needed	Rapid test to determine when no longer infectious after a positive case; rapid test daily for 10 days after probable close contact exposure
Return from Infection	Negative rapid test or after 7 days	Return when symptoms abate AND EITHER 1) test negative on rapid test or 2) after being out for 7 days
QUARANTINE	Not necessary with testing & masking	Not necessary for classroom exposures and not necessary for other exposures such as household close contacts provided testing & masking for 10 days past the exposure
Notifications SAME SAME SAME SAME SAME SAME SAME SAME	Contact office if child is ill; School will notify if there is an outbreak situation	Let the Office know about your child's illness; we will let you know if outbreak in child's classroom, but no more school wide notifications
